Hello Students,

We have been doing a good job with ensuring that our campus is a safe place for both students and staff/faculty to be in community daily. However, the time to be diligent in our investment to use precautions is more important than ever.

We received news that we now have a student who has tested positive for covid-19 with more tests being completed late this week. We have worked through contact tracing to ensure those who had immediate contact or secondary contact and exposure are also either being tested and/or quarantining.

Because of this news, we need to create extra safety standards and they are as follows:

- Until further notice, we are limiting the gymnasium use and closing the fitness center completely.
- Three athletic teams suspended practices until we learn about more the nature of this virus as it pertains to our campus.
- For the near future (at least until Oct. 14) we are closing "open res halls." This means there will be no open dorms or visitors allowed until next Wednesday.
- In the commons, we are limiting students and booths/tables to a 1:1 ratio. Only one student per space until
 further notice.
- Wear masks when in buildings. It is time to recommit ourselves to wearing masks, using distance inside and outside and washing our hands.

We are not intending to lead with fear, but rather with diligence. We have enjoyed our time together on campus so far this semester, and our vision is to be people of action and catch this early rather than react later when there may be more positive cobid-19 tests and it being harder to reign in. I will be emailing you with updates on the bulleted points listed earlier by Wednesday of next week.
