In compliance with the Federal Student Aid Handbook, Grace Christian University Financial Aid has determined its FSEOG funds will be awarded to students with the lowest expected family contributions (EFC) who will also receive Pell Grants in that award year.

The Dept. of Ed will determine the total funds available each year. It is the policy at Grace that FSEOG funds will be awarded to zero EFC's first. Due to the state FAFSA deadline of March 1st, many student's FAFSAs are completed earlier in the year, but Grace desires to provide FSEOG funds to returning students as well. The Financial Aid Office will allocate a specific amount of FSEOG funds for new students, returning students and Online students, based on the previous year's awards. If funds are depleted in one of these groups, awarding will stop.

After confirming enrollment changes for 2nd semester, the Financial Aid Office will review if there are any FSEOG funds still available. Any remaining funds may be awarded to transfers students starting in the Spring, or may be awarded to previously eligible students who started in the Fall, who did not receive the award. When FSEOG funds are depleted, the Financial Aid Office will stop awarding FSEOG.
