- The personality and Deity of the Holy Spirit.
- The essential unity of all believers in this present Dispensation of Grace as members of the one true Church, the Body of Christ.
- The privilege and duty of all the saved to walk as children of light.
- The Communion of the Lord's Supper as revealed through the apostle Paul for members of the Body of Christ, "until he comes."
- The one divine baptism by which believers are made members of the Body of Christ is the only baptism necessary in God's spiritual program in this Dispensation of the Grace of God.
- The resurrection of the body.
- The Pre-tribulation rapture of the members of the Body of Christ.
- The personal, pre-millennial return of Christ to reign on earth.
- The eternal punishment of the unsaved dead.
- The worldwide preaching of the gospel which Paul called "my gospel" (Romans 16:25) in contrast to the gospel of the circumcision.
