Dear Student,

As part of the ongoing effort of the Federal Government to provide relief to individuals and institutions affected by the COVID-19 pandemic, federal Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds (HEERF) have been made available to Grace Christian University students who were enrolled at Grace between March 13, 2020 and June 30, 2021. The actual dollar amount posted to your account is based on criteria provided to us by the federal government. Here are some facts for you to know:

1. The dollars posted to your account will show up as HEERF GRANT.
2. The HEERF Grant is from the federal government and does not need to be repaid.
3. If you have a balance due on your Grace account, these dollars can be applied to your balance. The federal government requires that Grace receive your consent to apply all or part of these dollars to any balance owed.
4. If you do not have a balance due on your Grace account, you may leave the Grant money on your account to be applied to next semester's costs.

 3. **Please leave the HEERF Grant on my account to be applied to a future account balance or paid to me at a later date.**
